4.1. Correspondence.

4.2. Business arising from previous minutes dated 8 June 2022.

1. Tassie.

Background.

With increasing fuel costs to road, shipping and air predominately driven by the Russia/Ukraine war which has created a global energy crisis and the 50% discount on fuel excise being removed in September along with restrictions on passengers travelling on cargo shipping resulting in the truck driver/convoyer having to be flown to Tassie with accommodation provided and the uncertainty in air travel [flight cancellations] due to staffing & COIVD, the cost in running the traditional Tassie races has close to doubled. Traditionally the WPF has covered the total costs of the transport. This is no longer viable and the cost to members would also be great.

The BOM has agreed to <u>replace</u> the traditional Yolla races with mid-week races using the TRPF transporter at a cost of \$2 per bird which will be covered by the WPF, and the prize entry will be \$5 per bird.

Capacity of unit 600 birds.

Current active flying member base 85.

Due to the structure of the units being used and their holding capacity each flyer will be given an allocation of 6 birds per race. This must be broken into 3 hens & 3 cocks per race per flyer.

Currently scheduled races to be replaced.

Yolla 10/09/2022, 40 bird limit, point score Yolla 10/09/2022, COCKS - 5 birder, point score.

Due to the weather unpredictability and reduced bird number capacity, we have scheduled 3 replacement races. If the weather forecast is deemed to have an impact on the race, the race will be cancelled. This decision will be based on discussions with the TRPF.
