## 2. Basketing.

- a. Opening of rooms.
- b. Setup.
  - i. BOM are looking for volunteers to open the rooms earlier for the older members whose health impacts their ability to arrive or stay later.
  - ii. Felix Lia has volunteered to open the room early to help those who need to commence basket earlier.
  - iii. The time will be confirmed but it will between around 5.30pm.
  - iv. Antoine Dalli to arrive at 5.30pm to assist.
  - v. A key to be provided.
  - vi. Training to be provided regarding setting up the rooms with units & clocks.

- 3. Unit unloading.
  - a. Two clubs of one club roster.
  - b. It was agreed that any club with >12 members to unload in their own wright.
  - c. Any club with less than 12 members to grouped with another club to ensure adequate numbers for unloading. Estimated numbers and groups below. Clubs to co-ordinate with each other.
  - d. M. Tenaglia to provide a roster prior to the commencement of racing.

- 4. Clocks.
  - a. Members must ensure they have entre all birds and check the registration of each bird. No birds will be fixed up during basketing. Members have plenty of time to check and correct any errors.
- 5. Payments.
  - a. Membership.
    - i. All clubs to collect and pay membership for 2024 before the commencement of the season so flying members can be finalised.
  - b. Races.
    - i. All clubs must pay their race bill within 7 days of race completion.
  - c. Rings.
    - i. All clubs to finalise payment of 2023 rings.
- 6. Concern raised by the members present regarding the registration and payment of GST.
- 7. Suggests made were.
  - a. Consideration be given to cancelling the Breeders Plate to reduce income to the WPF.
  - b. Reduce the bird limit to 40 birds from 50 for the earlier race.
  - c. Concern raised regarding taking a percentage of the prize money for the trailer fund.
  - d. Suggestions.
    - i. We run more sales such as Stock Bird Sale, Race team sales. All Club Secretaries and presidents confirmed they would support this.
    - ii. Include GST in the entry price but not Take any other fund. le. \$1.00 inclusive of GST [prize money \$0.90, GST = \$0.10.
    - iii. Add GST to the entry price but not take any other funds. le. 1.00 plus GST [1.00 + 0.10 = 1.10].

- e. Research in response.
  - i. Note the removal one type of sale only to be replaced by a different type of sale i.e. cancel Breeders' Plate but then have "race team" and "stock bird" sales would most likely negate the reduction in income to the WPF which defeats the purpose and GST will still apply.
  - ii. Based on 2023 number the excess bird age would have been 2157. This would have minimal impact of the reduction of income to not register for GST.
