IMPORTANT REMINDER TO EXHIBITORS

ANPA recommends vaccination of entries for the PMV1 and ROTA viruses. This includes birds taken into the show hall for auction or sale. Vaccination is NO LONGER MANDATORY. All birds are entered at the OWNER'S RISK.



2025 SHOW CONDITIONS

ENTRY FEES

Seniors: \$20 First Entry which includes the printed Catalogue of entries and a 2025 coat patch. \$4 second and subsequent entries

Juniors: (must be aged at least 5 years and not more than 15 on the day of the show)

\$15 First Entry which includes the printed Catalogue of entries and a 2025 coat patch. Free for second and subsequent entries.

ELIGIBILITY

• Entries will be accepted only from current individual financial members of ANPA, Melbourne Pigeon Society and Geelong & Districts 'All Breeds' Club.

This will be checked and any entries from non-members or unfinancial members will be returned. Entries will not be accepted from any person who has been refused membership of either ANPA or MPS regardless of that person's status in any other club.

• The Host Club Show Committee reserves the right to refuse to accept any entry/entries deemed to be a risk to the smooth running of the show.

• All birds at the venue are at the owner's risk and no responsibility is accepted by ANPA, MPS or Geelong & District 'All Breeds' club.

• Payment of all entry fees and Presentation Dinner tickets must accompany the signed entry form and all cheques/money orders must be payable to the MPS Inc. Post with the entries to the National Show Secretary PAUL SULJA. Please Include a stamped, self-addressed envelope to confirm acknowledgement and receipt of your entries. Email entries accepted only with confirmed Direct Deposit payment advice.

• Juniors: Please note that Juniors are not permitted to exhibit the same breed as a senior living at the same address, regardless of whether that senior is exhibiting at this show. To compete in junior classes, junior members must attend the show and pen their own exhibits, unless school attendance precludes it. A request if unable to meet this requirement will be considered by Show Committee. Juniors should note this on their entry form.

• All exhibits must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor from the time of entry through exhibition.

• Pen numbers will be released to exhibitors on their arrival at the show. It is therefore necessary that you retain a record of your entries.

• Security is paramount, and your patience is requested for any inconvenience. No bird, other than for exhibition (or sale after that breed judging is completed, or for the auction) is to be taken into the show area. Special areas are provided for sale and auction entries.

• All boxes and crates must be placed in the storage areas provided. Stewards will be on duty and will check all boxes and bags leaving the venue. No exhibits will be allowed to leave the pavilion until all exhibitors have retrieved or accounted for all their birds following the close of the show on Sunday.

• Sale Birds: Pens will be allocated for Sale Birds which must be entered on the Entry Form. Pens are \$10 each and are strictly limited to four birds per pen. Other Sale birds can be entered in the show in their sections and displayed as a sale bird BUT ONLY AFTER completion of their Breed judging. "For Sale" cards will be available from the National Show Secretary.

• Developmental/Genetics Class: Show classes are provided for breeds in development or for new colours being developed in existing breeds. Please note that this is not a class for "funny" colours produced by crossing existing colours within a breed, but for specific projects to introduce a genotype not present in a breed or to create a new breed in Australia. The Committee may award a special trophy for the best exhibit in the Developmental/Genetic Class.

SECURITY: No bird is permitted to leave the show Hall without written authority of the National Show Manager Paul Sulja. No sale bird is permitted to leave the Sale area without a receipt signed by the vendor.

SHOW AWARDS

NATIONAL CHAMPION AWARDS

All breeds listed (printed in bold) in the Schedule will be considered for the award of National Champion and will receive the ANPA National Champion card provided the judge considers the bird to be of sufficient standard to hold the title of National Champion. Likewise, ANPA national trophies will be available for all breeds subject to there being ten (10) exhibits entered in each. In the case of only one exhibitor in the breed, the National Show Coordinator will source a second opinion.

NATIONAL YOUNG BIRD AWARDS

ANPA may award a National Young Bird Card to the Best Young Bird of every breed (printed in bold) provided the judge considers the bird to be of sufficient standard to hold the title of National YB Champion. Likewise, ANPA national trophies will be available subject to there being eight (8) or more young bird exhibits of the breed. In the case of only one exhibitor in the breed, the National Show Coordinator will source a second opinion.

BEST JUNIOR EXHIBIT

ANPA may award a trophy to the best junior exhibit in each breed subject to there being eight (8) or more junior exhibits in that breed. All juniors participating in the National show will receive a memento. ANPA will award a trophy for the best overall junior exhibit and for the runner-up Best Junior. Note: The best junior exhibit in each breed will be considered for the respective best of breed awards and will be judged by the breed judge. Entries in the junior classes should include a "J" alongside the respective class number and state the junior exhibitor's age on the Entry Form.

PRESENTATION DINNER: Will be held at the RACV Goldfields Resort at 6.30pm on Saturday. There will be a buffet meal costing \$65 with drinks at bar prices. Indicate any special dietary requirements on the entry form.

CATERING AT SHOW: Shelley's Snack Shack food truck will sell a variety of hamburgers, chips, dim sims and chicken options including vegetarian, as well as egg, bacon and cheese rolls for breakfast.

SHOW PHOTOGRAPHY: Ambleside Poutry Photography will be taking photographs of the Champions and Best Young of every breed after that breed's judging is complete. This will commence on Saturday morning, and we ask owners of all the winning birds to bring those birds to the photography area.

JUDGES: The judging list in this Schedule is subject to change without notice. ANPA and the Show Committee sincerely thank each of the Judges for accepting the invitation to officiate at this show.

RINGS: All old birds must wear one ring of the correct size issued by ANPA only. All young birds must be rung with a 2024 ring of the correct size issued by ANPA and must be entered in the young bird classes provided. The only exception will be for birds entered in the Homer Group- Racing Pigeon Show Type, Classes 2285-2312 and Flown Racers, Classes 2801-2836. As dual-purpose birds, entries in those classes will be accepted for birds rung with either correct size ANPA rings or bona-fide Australian Racing Rings only. Only correctly rung birds will be accepted for exhibition and are eligible for awards. Marking rings must be removed prior to penning to avoid being disqualified.

- Exhibitors and spectators must keep well clear while judging is in progress. All will be allowed reasonable access to observe judging subject to the ANPA Code of Conduct.
- * The ANPA Code of Conduct will be strictly adhered to and enforced. Conduct violations include but are not limited to: Anyone engaged in chastising or rude questioning directed at the judge or otherwise indicating ownership of birds known.

Persons offending in such a manner will be warned (once only) and then if further infringement, depending on severity, will result in the person being asked to leave the judging area/pavilion or a disqualification of the offender's exhibits. With severe infringements both will be applied. The entry form must have your Entrant's signature to confirm your acceptance of the Code of Conduct and all Show Conditions.

At no time after birds are penned can they be handled, or their pen accessed, by anyone other than by their owner, or the Show Committee's approved breed steward. Owners are permitted to prepare their birds during judging, and they can be carried to and from the judging by their owner, or stewards under the control of the nominated and approved breed steward.

- The committee will not be held responsible for any loss or injury sustained to any exhibit though every care will be taken. In all circumstances the judge's decision will be final, with no provisions for appeal or disputes.
- Judges may withhold placings, awards, trophies, rosettes or certificates at their discretion.
- The owner of any exhibit deemed sick or carrying excess vermin of any description will be instructed to remove the bird from the venue.
- If any exhibit is disqualified from competition, all fees will be forfeited.
- Exhibitors are responsible for all freight arrangements.

RING AUCTION

The traditional ANPA Ring auction for 2025 numbers 1-100 in all sizes will be held at approximately 9am-9.30am on Sunday. Rings will be offered in three batches for each size (1-10) (11-50) (51-100).

Tendered ring offers will be accepted from ANPA members not attending the event. Email or Mail to Paul Sulja (RINGS OFFER) These must be received by Friday, July 11. Please include phone contact, so you are in the bid. Successful postal/phone bids add postage \$10.
