The Victorian Racing Pigeon Body (VRPB) wish to advise that properties that keep more than 50 poultry (including pigeons) must have a Property Identification Code (PIC), a legal requirement under the Livestock Disease Control Act 1994.

Property identification is used to trace and control diseases and residue problems that may be detected, locate properties, and contact owners and industry representatives. PICs are also used for emergency relief and recovery activities within an impacted zone.

The application can be completed online, or alternatively, you can complete and send in the paper application form. The process is completely free and should not take more than 10 minutes.
